The Interconnections Department Manager is responsible for the operations and daily performance of the team of Interconnection Utility Coordinators. Interconnection Department Manager is responsible for the overall success in all stages of interconnection, which includes compiling, responding to deficiencies, and obtaining interconnection agreements with various utilities. This position requires an ability to think critically, collaboration with individuals and teams, and a passion for delivering high quality results.

Responsibilities

- Oversee the submission of utilities applications online, through email, and mail.
- Employ problem-solving skills to resolve any rejections issued by utility companies.
- Communicate with customers to resolve utility rejections when appropriate.
- Determine the requirements of utility companies for interconnection projects.
- Monitor the status of submitted applications diligently, proactively managing the approval process within the established timelines.
- Prepare and submit Permission to Operate (PTO) applications to relevant utilities once installation and inspection are completed.
- Ensure a smooth transition by facilitating the submission of all required documentation to customers for signature.
- Occasionally handle inbound calls from utility companies or customers regarding utility rejections or getting customer systems turned on.
- Prepare and retrieve any required missing information for project submissions.
- Manage and track multiple interconnection projects simultaneously.
- Serve as the liaison between internal teams, customers, and utility companies to ensure smooth project progression.
- Make application fee payments and accurately record the information.
- Mail letters as necessary for project communication.
- Reach out to utility representatives to determine next steps when they are not apparent.
- Review CAD/Design documents, utility bills, and agreement documents to ensure proper adherence to the interconnection application process.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Requirements

- Bachelor's degree preferred or equivalent in work experience.
- Strong proficiency in MS Office (Outlook, Excel, PowerPoint, Word) and Salesforce CRM
- 2-5 years' experience in managing Solar utility applications and interconnection projects.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills required.
- Excellent customer service skills with the ability to build and maintain good relationships.
- Basic knowledge of utility distribution grid interconnections, net metering, renewable energy
- Ability to understand basic electrical concepts (e.g., voltage, current, power, energy)
- Interconnection experience with backup batteries required.
- Must be detail oriented and must be able to stay focused while submitting utility applications to not cause any discrepancies in information.
- Must be able to communicate professionally through email and over the phone.
